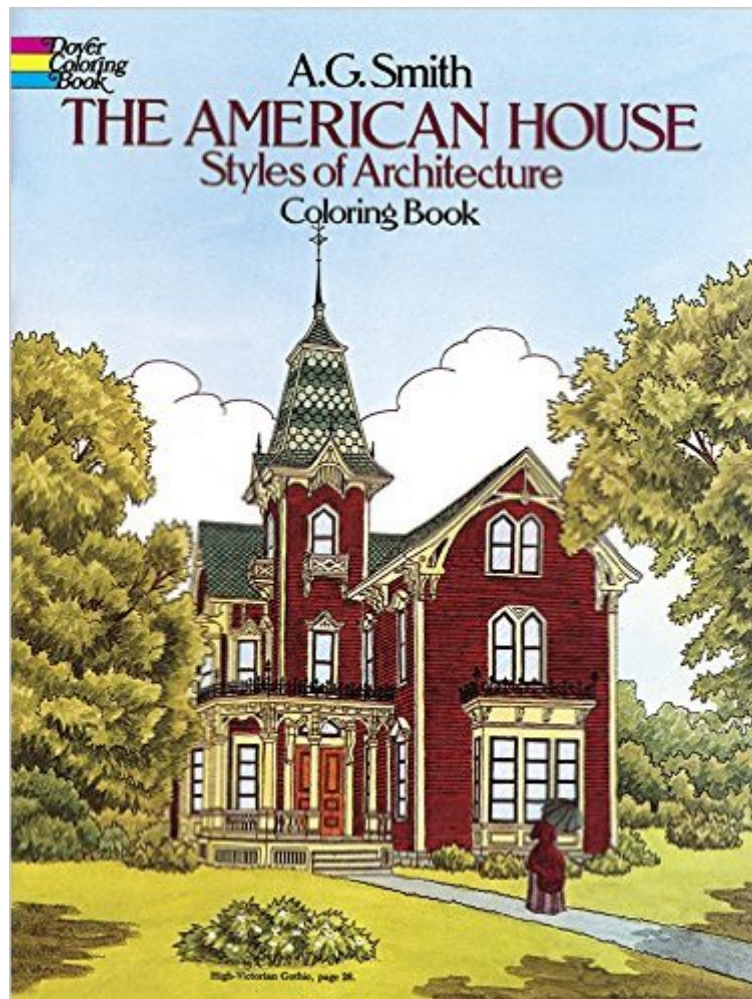

I greatly enjoyed coloring these exceptionally well rendered drawings. All kinds of dwellings/houses are featured, including foregrounds of trees, etc., and occasionally tiny people are pictured dressed

as they would be from that period. There were also comments made about each, which I found interesting and informative. The pictures contain small details. Definitely not for a child. I would say this is a coloring book for adults. Highly recommended.

The pictures in this book are on back-to-back pages, so the only medium you can use are colored pencils and even they will show through onto the other side. This is more like a history lesson book about early American houses more on the level for a pre-teen to learn from and color. Was not impressed at all!

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
