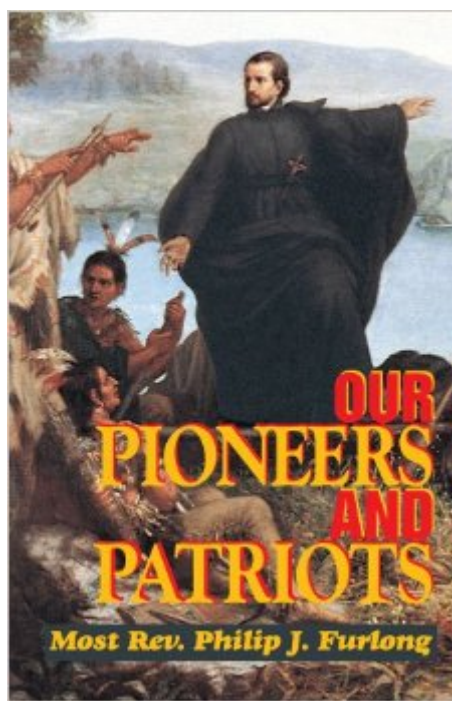

I am using this text plus the answer key for the first time this year with my fifth grade social studies class. It is an excellent source that makes social studies very accessible to this grade. I use Well-Trained Mind for my History pedagogy, and this book works well for the kids keeping a history binder. Every chapter review has people to know, places to know, and terms to know. There are ideas for creative activities with each chapter. The only drawback is that the language used is somewhat archaic. If a teacher doesn't mind explaining that gay means brightly-colored and negroes are African-Americans, it is an excellent text. I hope to continue to use it in future years.

The writing has constant definitions interrupting the narrative, and the review questions are fewer and way easier. I will keep it for future homeschooling in case I teach this subject to a 4th grader. It is too easy for my 6th grader. The information is good and interesting, if you have a kid at the right reading level.
