

The book is very colorful so it should hold the attention of a child too young to really understand the words too. As for the story it is basic, exactly as a board book should be, with just a simple sentence on each page. It is educational as well with Duck and Goose looking for places to hide in wait for the Easter Bunny. It explains simple concepts as too high, etc, with a simple picture to go along with it. You only see the Easter Bunny on one page. The page is a nighttime scene where the Easter Bunny is sneaking away, all shadowy. You have to point him out to kids/babies. It's a very cute book and my daughter liked the sparkle on the pages. She's at just the right age to like it, and will enjoy it for some time. Don't expect it to be exciting for one year olds. It's got a little bit of a story so it won't hold their attention yet.

This was our first Duck book purchase ... and not real thrilled over it. The book is sturdy and artwork is colorful, but story was lacking. With asking questions, pointing out pictures, and making up own story we were able to keep it interesting. Doubt it will be a book picked up often though. Sorry.
