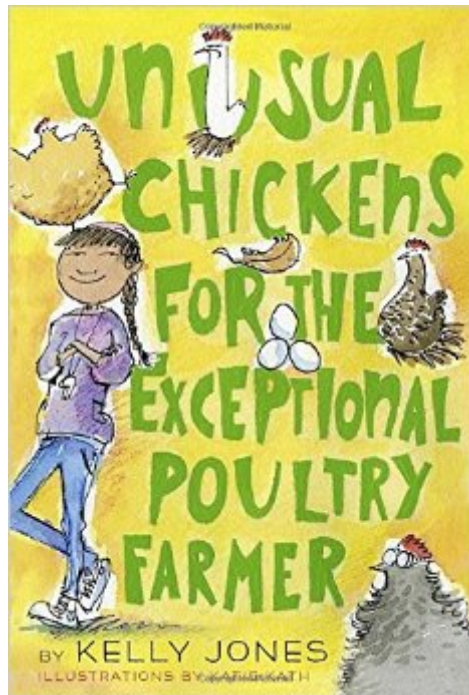

Of course now that I've read *Unusual Chickens for the Exceptional Poultry Farmer* • I will at long last be able to pull at least one book from my crazy overstuffed attic of a brain instantaneously. Kelly Jones's book manages with charm and unexpected panache to take the art of chicken farming and turn it into a really compelling narrative. Beware, though. I suspect more than one child will leave this book desirous of a bit of live poultry of their very own. You have been warned. After her dad lost his job, it really just made a lot of sense for Sophie and her family to move out of L.A. to her deceased great-uncle Jim's farm. Still, it's tough on her. Not only are none of her old friends writing her back but she's having a hard time figuring out what she should do with herself. She spends some of her time writing her dead Abuelita, some of her time writing Jim himself (she doesn't expect answers), and some of her time writing Agnes of the Redwood Farm Supply. You see, Sophie found a chicken in her back yard one day and there's something kind of strange about it.
