

Then in 1964 Shel Silverstein's creativity flourished with the publication of *Don't Bump the Glump!*, *A Giraffe and a Half*, *Who Wants a Cheap Rhinoceros?*, and the beloved classic *The Giving Tree*. Later he continued to build his remarkable body of work with *Where the Sidewalk Ends*, *A Light in the Attic*, *Falling Up*, *Every Thing On It*, *The Missing Piece*, *The Missing Piece Meets The Big O*, and *Runny Babbit*.
